Community Grants projects are designated for the planning, design, and construction of drinking water, wastewater, stormwater infrastructure and for water quality protection.

Project Objective and Need

This project would replace infrastructure that has reached the end of its useful life with new infrastructure that is more efficient and better suited to address future, stricter wastewater effluent permit requirements.

This will improve water quality coming from the treatment plant. The water, as a result of the new clarifiers, will be better for the environment and wildlife that relies on the water, as it moves through Springbrook Creek.
